3	Beginner Reiner Open	May be ridden 1 or 2 handed; any NRHA approved headgear; no running martingale. Restricted to riders with less than \$500 NRHA lifetime winnings in reining competitions as of the start of the year.	Modified Pattern 6
4	Beginner Reiner Youth 13 and Under	Riders up to 13 years old as of January 1st of current year. May be ridden 1 or 2 handed; running martingale optional (must be outfitted with rein stoppers); NRHA legal headgear; modified pattern with no lead changes. Riders may use a horse without the restrictions of ownership for Youth classes as defined in the Youth Conditions.	Modified To be posted
5	Beginner Reiner Youth 14-18	Riders 14 years to 18 years old as of January 1st of current year. May be ridden 1 or 2 handed; running martingale optional (must be outfitted with rein stoppers); NRHA legal headgear; modified pattern with no lead changes. Riders may use a horse without the restrictions of ownership for Youth classes as defined in the Youth Conditions.	Modified To be posted
6	Reining Youth All Ages 18 and Under	Riders up to 18 years old as of January 1st of current year.	Pattern 13
7	Reining Non-Pro	Open to any NRHA Non-Pro cardholder	Pattern 3
